Then came the great **battles** of Kursk, Stalingrad (Volgograd), Tula, Minsk, Kiev, Odessa, Sevastopol, Novorossiisk. Some of these cities are **Hero**-Cities.

All Soviet people are proud of our **talented** generals: G.K. Zhukov, I.S. Konev, K.K. Rokossovsky, A.M. Vasilevsky. We will never forget the names of Alexander Matrosov, Zoya Kosmodemyanskaya, twenty-eight men of General Panfilov's **division**, the **young** men from Krasnodon, the heroes of the Brest Fortress. Over 20 million people died but Hitler didn't conquer the USSR.

On May 9, 1945 the war was over in Berlin.

Now Victory Day is one of the most important holidays. There is a **parade** of **veterans** in every town and city of our Motherland. People put flowers to the Memorial of the Unknown Soldier to remember those who didn't come back from the war.
