Festive Film Team Trivia quiz

Adapted from Film, part of the Resource Books for Teachers series, Pages 44-46



Level Elementary and above

Time15-20 minutes

Materials A 60-90 second festive film clip in which a wide variety of images are shown.

Preparation Cue the film

Procedure

- 1. Explain the task to the students. First, they are going to watch a short film clip. After viewing the clip they have to write down as many visual things as they can remember. Depending on the level of the class they might mention objects or people, with descriptions, processes, actions or even more abstract things such as emotions or concepts.
- 2. Play the video clip.
- 3. Allow a few minutes to write down all the things they noticed.
- 4. Explain that they are now going to choose one or two of these visual details to make into questions. For example: What colour scarf was Kevin wearing? What does Kevin put under the carpet? What does he pour on the front steps? How many buckets of paint did he pick up?
- 5. Divide the class into two teams, or an even number of smaller groups.
- 6. Give the members of each team 5 minutes to consolidate their questions into a list with enough questions for the number of members of the opposite team.
- 7. Teams take turns asking members of the other team a question. Individual members of each team take turns asking questions and responding. Score 1 point for each correct answer. If necessary replay the clip to check questions and answers.
- 8. To finish, watch the whole clip again at the end (and maybe a little bit more) so students can see how it fits in to the story.
